#### CONNECTIVITY ACCESS PLAN

Parents,

A supervised in-person “learning lab” will be available for students who do not have WiFi access. Pu`u Kukui must prioritize the health & safety of our students, staff, and greater community. As such, we will open our covered Playcourt from 8:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. on Mondays - Fridays, except holidays, beginning Monday, August 24. The Playcourt is set up with individual computer desks, spaced 6 feet apart, for students and their parent/guardian to sit. The Playcourt is open-air with proper ventilation.



- ★ The Playcourt allows our students to safely have Internet access to our school WiFi in order to participate in synchronous and asynchronous instruction. Students must bring their school assigned tech device with them. Please ensure your tech device is fully charged at 100% battery power prior to coming onto campus. Parents must provide their child with their own earphones since it may be difficult to hear while online.
- ★ Parents may park in the Cafeteria Parking Lot. All parents and students must sign-in on the sign-in sheet located inside the Playcourt to document who is on campus each day. All parents and students must use hand sanitizer upon entering and exiting the Playcourt.
- ★ The expectation is that one parent/guardian will bring the student(s) and remain with the student inside the Playcourt for the entire duration of time that the student is on campus. It is the parent/guardian’s responsibility to ensure the student is participating and engaging in instructional activities. It is the parent/guardian’s responsibility to ensure the student is accessing the proper websites/learning platforms. The parent/guardian is also responsible for ensuring the safety of their child at all times.
- ★ Parents should not be a distraction to other students in the Playcourt. There should be no use of cell phones (phone calls, texting, social media, etc.) that could interfere with the learning environment for all of the other students who will be using the same space.

- ★ Children who do not attend Pu`u Kukui may not be brought into the Playcourt.
- ★ The Playcourt has one restroom which students and their parents will have access to. All parents and students who use the restroom must ensure they are washing their hands with soap for at least 20 seconds.
- ★ An Adult Supervisor will supervise the Playcourt to ensure everyone follows our [PKES Family Handbook - COVID-19 Health & Safety Mandatory Guidelines](#). The Adult Supervisor is unable to assist with any instructional activities.
- ★ There will not be access to face-to-face contact with any teacher. If the student is in need of instructional assistance, please call or email your child's teacher.
- ★ Should you need Technical Assistance, our HIDOE has an `Ohana Help Desk to support students and parents by phone. The `Ohana Help Desk can be reached Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. - 8:00 p.m. and on Sundays from 4:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. at 808-643-DESK (3375). The `Ohana Help Desk is closed on state holidays. Also, online services will be available 24/7 at [ohanahelpdesk.org](http://ohanahelpdesk.org) for self-service support and information.
- ★ All students and their parent/guardian must wear a face mask at all times and maintain 6 feet social distance.
